



(CVI) program is sought by NADCA members and HVAC cleaning industry contractors who are interested in demonstrating a higher level of professionalism and knowledge.

The ASCS certification credential is a prerequisite for anyone wishing to sit for the CVI exam. Individuals with a CVI certification have demonstrated knowledge to perform HVAC system inspection in compliance with NADCA's standards and guidelines. CVIs also have demonstrated proficiency in advanced knowledge of HVAC systems and their impact on indoor air quality.

To obtain either the ASCS or CVI certification, an individual is required to take and pass a multiple choice exam. These exams are available through several different outlets, including but not limited to, NADCA testing centers, the NADCA Annual Meeting & Exposition, and the NADCA Fall Technical Conference.


